

TEL Announces Learn Together! Project

TEL EDUCATION, A NON-PROFIT CURRICULUM AND EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN OKLAHOMA CITY, ANNOUNCED TODAY THE LAUNCH OF LEARN TOGETHER!, A COMMUNITY INITIATIVE TO PROVIDE FREE LEARNING RESOURCES TO HIGH SCHOOL AND COLLEGE INSTRUCTORS, STUDENTS, AND FAMILIES.

According to TEL Education Executive Director, Dr. Rob Reynolds, “Learn Together! is a collective effort to provide extended and free support for schools, organizations, families, and students during the disruptions related to the COVID-19 virus. As events began to unfold, we worked with our partners to explore how we might offer free learning libraries to support people around the country. In the end, we determined that the best solution would be to create branded resource sites for institutions that they could distribute through their own networks.”

Each Learn Together! site features a complete set of free, openly licensed learning content for 15 general education courses. In addition, sites include learning materials for educators, families, and students to support both virtual and self-guided learning.

Current Learn Together! partners include Harding University, Jacksonville College, Ohio Christian University, Oklahoma Wesleyan University, York College, and the National Christian Schools Association. Reynolds says that the project is open to any institution, school, or organization interested in sharing free learning resources with their local or regional community.
